National Opioid and Substance Awareness Day will host a virtual **town hall** event from **12:00-3:00 pm EDT** where participants will learn from experts and from those with lived experience about substance misuse and treatment, and will be able to take free, anonymous, online screenings for themselves or a loved one. For those who screen positive or still have concerns about substance use, there will be referrals to local treatment resources. Partners for the day's program include, Patrick Kennedy and the Kennedy Forum, SAMHSA, Mental Health America, The Voices Project, AATOD, and AAAP. The event will host an array of speakers including Dr. Nora Volkow, Director of the National Institute on Drug Abuse (NIDA) and remarks from Massachusetts State Senator, Julian Cyr, a leading advocate addressing the addiction problem in Massachusetts.
